
- First Roman stronghold





- Man-made beach similar to most of Qatar's urban coastlines







- Trip leaders are asked to mindful of any entry country vaccinations.
- Medication will be stored with, and dispensed, by a designated trip adult. This will be given to the assigned teacher once the student list has been finalized and prior to the date of departure.
- ALL trip leaders, deputies and chaperones should have up-to-date certified First Aid training. Details of this to follow – one 6-hour session or two 3-hour sessions. Those who received training in November, 2021 do not have to take this course prior to the WWW 2023.
- Students who have emergency medications such as an Epipen MUST bring two epipens; one which they will have on their person and one which will be given to an assigned adult on the trip who has certified First Aid training.
- All medications must be in the original package with labels.
- Packing list, as appropriate.



Students who are ill

Students who present with multiple symptoms such as fever 37.8C within 48 hours, sore throat, body aches, chills, fatigue, or diarrhea and vomiting 24 hours before departure will be asked to remain at home.

Entry Visas

Parents are responsible to arrange any required entry visas and to ensure that passports are up-to-date with 6 months' validity.



Parents must:

- ensure that all travel documents are up-to-date. Be prepared to submit a copy and have all necessary and official documents for travel;
- complete and return the parent permission slip to trip leader(s) by Sunday, 5 March;
- ensure student health records and information are up-to-date;
- ensure that students have comprehensive medical insurance;
