Grades	Activities	Description
6, 7, 8	<b>Figurine Sculpting (Group 1)</b>	This activity will take students through hand sculpting and modelling. Students will choose a superhero or icon from a movie or television series that they want to sculpt using modelling clay. All the tools and tutorials necessary to sculpt their chosen model will be provided. Following on from this process, students will render and paint the model, giving it an aesthetic finish. Students who complete the hand modelling, will move onto 3D modelling their designs and using a 3D printer to complete the process.

6, 7, 8	<b>Robotics</b>	Students will learn the basics of Arduino programming and will create their own, programmable smart car template in readiness for a final competition. Necessary Items: 1. Students need to bring their own computer with functionally working USB ports. 2. Computers with micro USB ports or USB-C ports must have an adaptor for USB ports. 3. Students must bring 2 batteries of 9 volts. 4. Students must bring in a USB-C cable compatible with their computer.
6, 7, 8	<b>Pottery</b>	In this pottery activity, participants will have the opportunity to explore both hand-built and wheel pottery techniques. The session will begin with a brief introduction to the properties of clay and an overview of the tools and materials used in pottery. Participants will then have the chance to experiment with hand-building techniques and learn how to use a pottery wheel. By the end of the session, participants will have gained a foundational understanding of both hand-built and wheel pottery techniques and will have created 2 pieces to take home once complete after 10 days.
